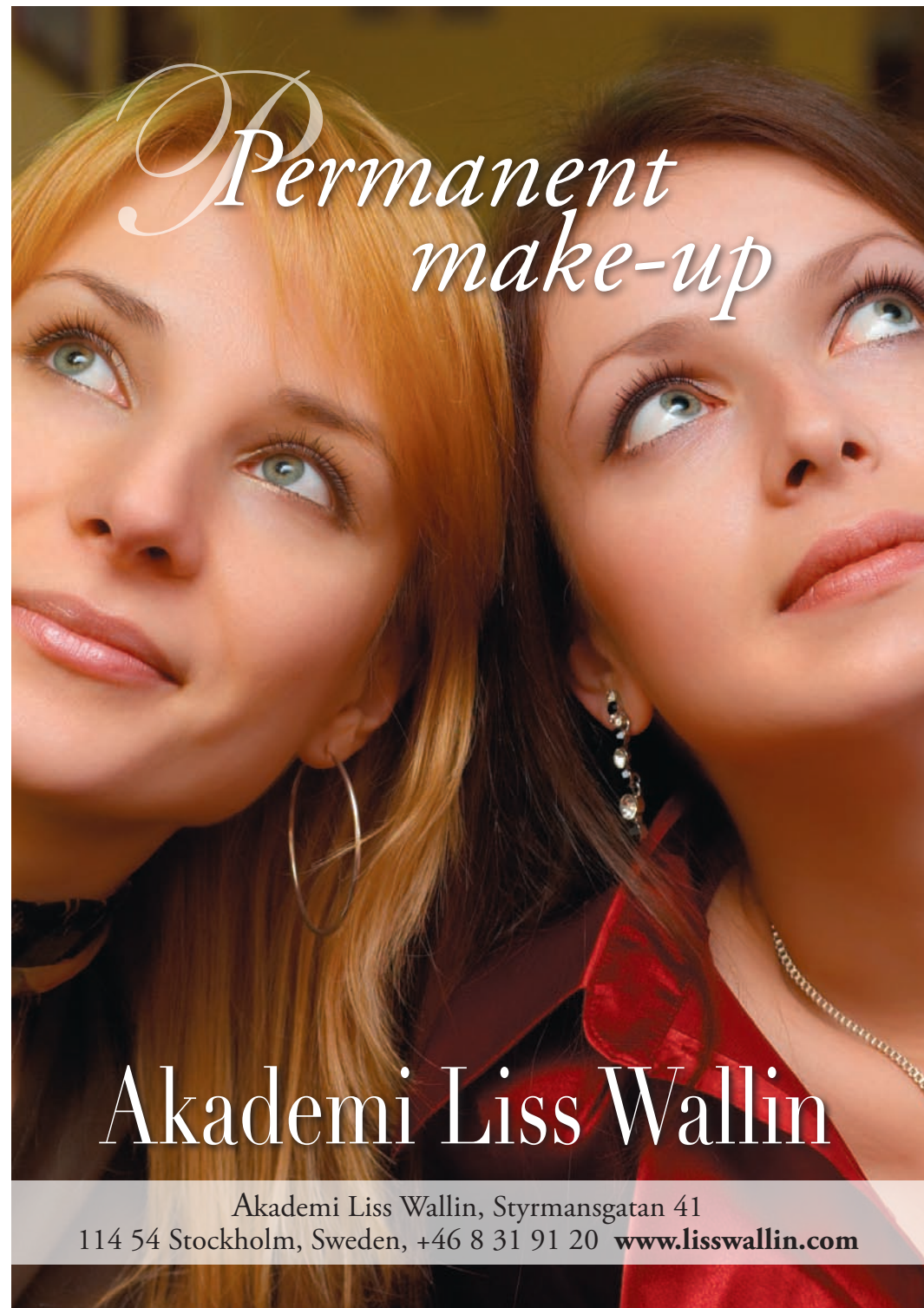


PERMANENT MAKE-UP ARTIST

PERMANENT MAKE-UP

This simple and safe method has been developed over several thousand years. It includes the introduction of micro-pigments of iron oxide down in to the second skin layer, creating a discreet shade of color in the skin. It is so natural that no one can detect where a hair ends and the pigment begins. The colors are completely natural and decreases with time down deeper in the skin so that the color fades out.

EYE LINER

Every morning you wake up just as beautiful.

Permanent eyeliner in exquisite colors that accentuates your natural contour of the eyes and the eyelashes. The result, with you permanently beautiful - both day and night.

LIP LINER

Permanent lip contour gives your mouth a fuller, more attractive appearance. Permanent colors correct asymmetric lips and mark the contour. Permanent lip color is individually mixed to suit your own colors and desires.

EYEBROWS

Permanent eyebrow color gives you a natural appearance. Not even your closest friends will be able to see that your brows are tattooed. I create the contour, color and density to your needs. The natural appearance ensures by mixing colors that blend in with your own skin and hair color. Mainly for men and women who have lost all or part of their eyebrows.

AREOLA RECONSTRUCTION

Permanent makeup is a very effective technique to re-create a natural nipple as possible after a breast operation. Plastic Surgeons ask for my knowledge and sensitivity in the case of a woman's needs.

SCAR CAMOUFLAGE

Carefully mixed colors, designed to resemble your skin tones, can be applied to scarred areas.

Hair loss in a scar after a facelift can be camouflaged with delicate hair strokes in the hairline gives you a very good results.

HAIR LOSS

Patchy hair loss, Alopecia and high hairline camouflages with thin hair strokes.

An anesthetic ointment may be used if necessary.

Q. Can I be allergic?

S. The pigments provokes no allergies, color test can be done.
